HAZARDS				
<b>Fire or Explosion</b>	May burn but do not ignite readily. Fire may produce irritating, poisonous and/or corrosive fumes. Containers may explode when heated. Runoff from fire control or dilution water may pollute waterways.			
<b>Health</b>	Inhalation or contact with substance may be harmful.			
<b>Protective Clothing</b>	<b>Emergency Services:</b> Wear SCBA and structural firefighter's uniform. <b>Minimum protective clothing for handling product:</b> Wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist and a washable hat, impervious work boots and elbow length PVC gloves.			
PUBLIC SAFETY				
<b>For all Emergencies</b>	ELIMINATE all ignition sources (no smoking, flares, sparks or flames) in the immediate area. Spill or leak area should be isolated immediately for at least 10 m in all directions. Keep unauthorised personnel away. Keep upwind and to higher ground. Send message to police and fire brigade. Tell them location, material, UN number, quantity and emergency contact as well as condition of vehicle and damage observed. Warn other traffic.			
<b>Evacuation</b>	When a large quantity of this material is involved in a major fire, consider initial evacuation for 100 m in all directions.			
EMERGENCY RESPONSE				
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Small fire</b> Use dry chemical, CO <sub>2</sub> , water spray or foam. <b>Large fire</b> Use water spray, fog or foam. If safe to do so, move undamaged containers from fire area. Cool containers with flooding quantities of water until well after fire is out.			
<b>Spill or Leak</b>	Do not touch or walk through spilled material. Stop leak if safe to do so - prevent entry into waterways, drains or confined areas. Water spray may be used to knock down or divert vapour clouds. Do not wash residues away with water. <b>SEEK EXPERT ADVICE ON HANDLING AND DISPOSAL.</b>			
<b>First Aid</b>	Remove victim to fresh air. Apply resuscitation if victim is not breathing. Administer oxygen if breathing is difficult. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes immediately. Remove material from skin immediately. In case of contact with material, immediately flush skin or eyes with running water for at least 15 minutes. Keep victim warm and quiet. Obtain immediate medical care. Ensure attending medical personnel are aware of the identity and nature of the product(s) involved, and take precautions to protect themselves.
